**ORDER of REVOCATION effective 12/12/2003**

Please read the following information carefully.

The records of this department indicate that you submitted to a chemical test of your blood or breath which disclosed that while you were operating a motor vehicle you had an alcohol content of 0.10 or more. You may request a hearing concerning this matter by applying in writing or in person to this office or in person at any driver license office prior to the effective date shown above. At the time of request, you must surrender any driver licenses and/or permits in your possession. If eligible, a 60 day permit will be issued.

You may also request the law enforcement officer be present at your hearing. You may request this at the time you request your hearing or you may subpoena the officer at least five calendar days prior to the hearing date.

If a written request is not received by 12/11/2003 you waive your right to a hearing and in conformity with 42-2-126 CRS, this being your first offense, your privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this state is hereby revoked for three months.

This order will remain in effect until 03/11/2004 and the following reinstatement requirements are met: 1) Payment of a reinstatement fee. 2) Filing of future proof of liability insurance in the form of an SR22. This form is obtained from your insurance company. 3) Completion of an alcohol certification that is available at our reinstatement offices. Once reinstated, you will be required to apply for a new driver license and/or permit.

A revocation pursuant to 42-2-126 CRS does not permit the consideration of any type of driving privileges during the revocation period except as provided in 42-2-126(6)(D) CRS.
